Impressionist Scarf/ Shawl

Pattern 1027

Skill level: advanced beginner

Design by Misti International

Finished measurements

Shawl:

Width: approx 27 cm /11 in (or desired width)

Length approx 150 cm/60 in (or desired length) + tassels

Yarn

Misti Alpaca **Chunky** (100% Baby Alpaca, 100 g = 109 yds), & Misti Alpaca **Lace** (100% Baby Alpaca, 50 grams each, 437 yards/400meters)

Chunky -200 grams: 2 hanks

Lace -100 grams: 2 skeins of **Lace**(or 1 hank of **Hand painted Lace** 100 gram hanks.

Needles

No 7 or 8 (US 10,5 or 11) or change needle size to obtain correct gauge

Gauge/Tension

approx 13 sts x 16 rows in pattern st =
10 x 10 cm /4 x 4 in



To Knit

Pattern:

[Row 1 and 2, Chunky: k all st (= 1 garter ridge)

Row 3: Baby Lace: k all sts

Row 4: Baby Lace: kfb (inc), knit until 2 sts remain, k2tog].

Rep these 4 rows.

The same number of sts will remain on every row throughout entire work (= inc 1 st at beg of row 4, dec 1 st at end of row 4).

Shawl:

With Chunky and ndls no 7 or 8 (US 10,5 or 11) CO (cast on) 35 sts and work pattern as explained and inc and dec as described. Cont until work meas approx 150 cm (or desired length). End with k 2 rows in Chunky (= 1 garter ridge). BO

Optional Finishing:

Make 4 long tassels of Chunky and fasten one to each corner of shawl. Shape and stretch shawl slightly.

Step 1: Cut the scrap cardboard as long as you want the fringe of the tassel to be. I cut my piece about 5" long. Wrap the yarn snugly around the cardboard. The more yarn you wrap, the wider the tassel will be.

Step 2: Cut about 4" of yarn and slip it under the wrapped yarn, against the cardboard. Gather the wrapped yarn together on the cardboard and then bundle it together with the small piece of yarn tied into a loose bow.

Step 3: Cut the yarn off of the cardboard at the bottom, opposite the bow. The fringe of the tassel will be held together by the bow.

Step 4: Untie the bow, and re-tie it into a very tight knot, cinching the yarn together as much as possible.

Step 5: Cut another piece of yarn, about 4" long. Fold the fringe of the tassel in half, around the knot from step 4. Wrap the piece of yarn you just cut around the top of the folded fringe, about 1" from the knot. Pinch it tightly and then tie it off and hide the ends of the knot inside the fringe.

Abbreviations

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

cont = continue

dec = decrease

inc = increase

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 together

rem = remain/remaining

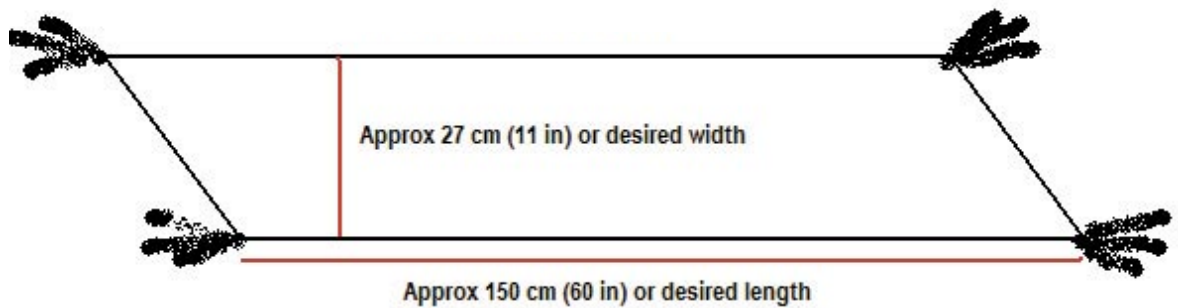
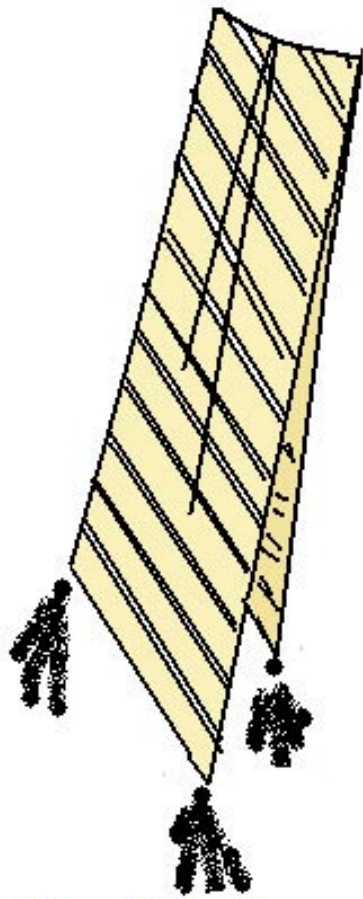
rep = repeat

st/sts = stitch/ stitches

kfb (inc) = knit front and back. Also called a Bar Increase, and k1f&b (knit 1 front & back). Knit a stitch, leaving stitch on left needle; knit into the back loop of this stitch.



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
