One size

Finished Measurements

Width, along bottom edge: 26in/66 cm
Length 8.25in/21 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Handpaint Chunky (100% baby alpaca, 100 g = approx 109 yards/100 meters), shown in color Winter Queen CP21
1 hank

Needles

U.S. 10 (6 mm), 24in/60cm circular or straight needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge
U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook

Notions

Two 1 1/8in/28mm buttons

Gauge/Tension

12 sts and 17 rows = 4in/10 cm in lace pattern

Knitting Notes

The lace pattern is worked on wrong side rows and will show on the right side when the edge is turned to the right side.

Stitch Glossary

M1: insert right needle under strand between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit through the back of the loop.



To knit

Loosely CO 60 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Row 2: K1, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3. Rep last 2 rows until piece measures approx 4.25in/11.5 cm from beg, end with a RS row.

Next (inc) row: K1, *k1, M1, k1, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1, M1, k2 = 75 sts.

Next row: K1, *p3, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

Next row: K1, *k3, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Next (inc) row: K1, *p3, k1, M1, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1 = 89 sts.

Next row (WS): K1, *k3, p1, yo, p2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4. Work 3 rows even. Rep last 4 rows twice more.

BO loosely knitwise; do not fasten off last st.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Do not block.

With crochet hook and RS facing, use rem st as first loop. Slip st in corner, work single crochet along edge to first inc row, *chain 2, skip next 3 rows along edge, single crochet in next row; rep from * once more, then work single crochet to cast-on edge. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to opposite edge under button loops.

Abbreviations

approx = approximately

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

in = inch, inches

inc = increase

k = knit

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 sts together

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

yo = yarn over
