Finished Measurements

Width: approx 20 cm (8 in)

Length: approx: 78 - 80 cm or 32 in

Yarn

Misti Alpaca *Baby Me Boo*

(50% Baby Alpaca, 30% Merino, 20% Bamboo Hand Paint 100 g = 174 yds) shown in BBH28 *Mikado*

1 hank

Needles

US 8 or 9 = 5 or 5,5 mm

Gauge/Tension

Approx 20 sts pattern = 10 cm or 4 in in width.

To knit

CO 40 sts. K 1 row loosely. Work pattern as explained loosely until full length.

Row 1: (WS): p2 (= edge sts), [k3tog, in next st (k1, p1, k1)], rep [] until 2 sts rem, p2 (= edge sts).

Row 2: k 2nd st in front of work, k 1st st, slide both sts off right hand ndl (= 2 edge sts), p all sts until 2 sts rem, k 2nd st in back of work, k 1st st, slide both sts off right hand ndl (= 2 edge sts).

Rpt row 1 and 2 for entire work. Cast off in p sts from WS.

Finishing

Sew edges tog for a tube/cowl or can be used as a long scarf.

Show off to friends and acquaintances.

Abbreviations

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

k3tog = knit 3 together

p = purl

rem = remain/remaining

rpt = repeat

st/sts = stitch/ stitches

WS = wrong side of work
