

Cabled Neck Wrap

Free Pattern 2045
Designed by Randi Sunde
Skill level: advanced beginner



To knit

CO 17 sts. Work pattern as explained until full length.

Row 1: k2 (= edge sts), k3, yo, k2, sl 2, k1, psso, k2, yo, k3, k2 (= edge sts)
Row 2, 4, 6, 8,10, 12: k edge sts, work
rem sts as they appear, p yo.
Row 3: k2 (= edge sts), k4, yo, k1, sl 2,
k1, psso, k1, yo, k4, k2 (= edge sts)
Row 5: k2, (= edge sts), k5, yo, sl 2, k1,
psso, yo, k5, k2 (= edge sts)
Row 7 + 9: k2, k6, p1, k6, k2
Row 11: k2, place 3 sts on cable ndl and
hold in back, k3, k sts from cable ndl,
p1, place 3 sts on cable ndl and hold in
front, k3, k sts from cable ndl, k2.
Rep row 1 - 12. End with row 11. Cast
off.

Finished Measurements

Width: approx 5 in (13 cm)

Length: approx 8 pattern repeats or 21 in (53 cm)

Yarn

Misti Alpaca **Best of Nature Chunky** (100% Baby Alpaca, All Natural Dyes, Hand Paint, 100 g = 109 yds, shown in BNO2 Berry, can be knit in any Misti Alpaca Chunky weight yarns!)

1 hank

Needles

US 10.5 = 7 mm. Crochet hook US J or 10 = 6 mm

Notions

cable needle stitch markers 2 beads (optional) for end of each pompons

Gauge/Tension

Approx 13 sts pattern = 4 in in width or 10 cm.

Finishing

Crochet loosely a row of sc along both edges. 1 sc every other row.

Cords at short edges: Pick up 3 sts at cast on/cast off row = centre of cable (= centre st + 2nd st to each side of this). From RS k 1 row, [sl sts to other end of ndl (do not turn), tighten yarn, k 1 row].Rep [] until cord meas approx 6 in or 15 cm (or desired length). Cast off.

Make one more cord at other end in the **Option**: same manner.

Fold each end nicely to a centre point and fasten with a couple of sts.

Pompon:

Ch4, join to a ring with 1 sl st, Rnd 1: 6 sc in the ring. Cont in rounds as spiral with 1 sc alt 2 sc in each sc on previous rnd until circle is large enough. ch Shape pompon by working 1 sc every sc for approx 1 rnd, then 2sc tog (= insert hook in sc, yo, insert hook in next sc yo and pull through all sts on hook).

Cont to work in rounds and at the same time shape pompon until a small hole rem. Cut yarn. Stuff pompon with rem yarn until a nice shape. Attach pompon to end of cord.

Finish other end in the same manner. Fasten a small bead at end of pompon (optional)

For a longer cable to tie: Use all yarn for cable but save some for crocheted edgings as explained.

Crochet picots at each end:

Picot: [ch3, 1 sl st in 1st ch, skip 1 st, 1 sc in next edge st]. Rep []

Abbreviations

= chain (using crochet hook)

CO = cast on inc = increase k = knit

=pass the slipped stitch over psso

= wrong side of work

= remain/remaining rem

= repeat rep = round rnd RS =right side sl st = slip stitch =single crochet SC st/sts= stitch/ stitches

= yarn over yo
